

B – Letter from Managing Editor of The Guardian

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Note – As the letters show my wife and I met with The Guardian 24 hours after arranging the meeting. Copies of my documentation disappeared from their secure offices as their editor admits. (a year later copies of this same documentation would disappear from a judge's court papers – the proof for this is that the judge mentions it in a hearing as the official court transcript shows). We were intimidated on the way home from the Guardian's offices. Nobody can explain. Academic S. Dorril in his book "MI6" stated that MI6 have agents inside newspapers in the UK. Could this explain the disappearance and the intimidation that followed our meeting with The Guardian

I understand that you are concerned but I think it almost impossible that any criminal gang could have mounted a plan to intimidate you and your wife within two hours of you leaving the Guardian's offices. (2)

Helen is willing to talk through your case with or without documents so please contact her at the Manchester office to arrange a time to speak to her. May I assure you that they have been truly lost for which, once again, I apologise.

Dear Ms. Bell

Very confidential documentation of a dangerous nature lost in your office.

I am bringing to your personal attention my concern that your newspaper's processes for the protection of sources of confidential information has been severely compromised in your Manchester office, and that this possible failure may have put my family and myself in danger.

On March 24th my wife and I visited your Manchester office and asked to speak to a reporter. We met with Mr. Mark Smith and handed him documentary information that shows that we have been intimidated and threatened by crime gangs that operate on behalf of elements that are high in the London establishment. The intimidation is to stop me from launching a civil law suit. We also provided a correspondence file that shows that although this matter has been brought directly to The Home Secretary's attention that the authorities are doing nothing since the parties involved operate at levels that are disgracefully above the law in England.

Mr Smith has told me that he passed the documentation to Ms. Helen Carter; Ms. Carter denies having received it.

I can't ask that you run my story, but I am deeply concerned that the information (which is very dangerous to my family) has disappeared from your office, and that the establishment-contacted crime gangs may have been alerted that I am now trying to contact the press. Two hours after leaving your office, my wife and I were again intimidated. My wife, my younger son (also a Chartered Accountant) and myself have all been threatened in Manchester on several occasions, my eldest son in Birmingham and my daughter, a student in Aberdeen, have also been threatened. If you had experienced the power and reach of these crime gangs, you would understand why I take the disappearance of my documentation so seriously. Indeed the intimidation, which has been going on for 5-years, is so sophisticated that we almost believe that elements of the security services may be involved.

Would you please find this documentary information, and also let me know if anyone outside your office has had sight of it.

Could you please pass on the enclosed attachment to your managing Editor, Mr. Chris Elliott. In it I am quoting a letter that he wrote me in 2005. I don't have his email address.

The background is this.

In April 2005 I met with your Northern Correspondent (Mr. Ward) and discussed a matter of criminal intimidation, and government cover up. Your Editor decided not to pursue the story which is fine. However I need the quote for two reasons - (1) After leaving your offices we were threatened four times, including recorded telephone death threats against my eldest son in Birmingham, and having a car smashed into my apartment in Manchester (2) The copies of my documentation that I filed with you mysteriously disappeared which is suggestive of intelligence service involvement since it disappeared again a year later when I filed it in a Court. My meeting with your people is therefore part of the evidence.

Just to follow up on your email of 2 Nov 2007 when you kindly agreed to pass some comments of mine onto your Managing Editor. As you may have noted I did use his letter in a personal publication that I made in Early December.

The issue was that after I left your Office in Manchester back in 2005 my wife and I were threatened by what we then thought were crime gangs, but now know to be adjuncts of MI5, MI6. The following weekend my wife was again intimidated and at the same time my eldest son in Manchester received several death threats that are recorded and in police hands - A transcript of these recorded threats is below my signature on this email, and I appologise for the language that MI5, MI6 use. The next night our house then in Manchester was smashed into, and a description of this is also outlined below my signature. All this happened three years ago. **A couple of months ago shots were fired into my son's house in Birmingham.** In all cases, of course, the police were stopped from investigating, since the Government is protecting the criminals, who are high in the establishment, from justice. I generally use the word Stasi in the description of all this (as I did in the article), but make no appologies for using the word nazi below since it is also very appropriate.

The real issue is the deliberate flouting by the government of rule of law, and the appalling override of values such as democracy, civil liberties, etc. Britain deserves better.

Since I will be blogging this stuff around, would you please confirm that you have received it.
